***Celebrity Sales has an obligation to the consignors of sale animals, and cannot allow The Grand Slam Llama Event and The Celebrity World Futurity to become a place for selling animals outside the sale. This is necessary to ensure the continued success of both the sale and the shows held that weekend. If, as a result of having your llama in The Grand Slam Llama Event '05 or the Celebrity World Futurity, you receive an unsolicited offer which you feel is too generous to decline, you must record the sale with Celebrity Sale management. There will be an assessment of 15% of the selling price on any sales resulting in the participation of these shows. Any unrecorded sales will result in the suspension of both the buyer and seller from future Celebrity Sale events. By signing The Grand Slam Llama Event '05 entry form you are agreeing to abide by the above policy.

Entries must be *received* by 03-04-2005 and mailed with no signature required!

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- This show is approved by the Alpaca and Llama Show Association, Inc. All- rules and guidelines for this show will be in accordance with the 13th edition ALSA handbook.
- Exhibitors must be the registered owners and make entry in the exact names (owner and animal) as shown on the registration certificate.

- All llamas entered in approved classes must be registered or have passed screening with the international lama registry, (ILR) or the Canadian Livestock Record Corporation (CLRC). If non-breeders are not registered and wish to be in the ALSA award system and wish to show in halter, they must show in the adult non-breeder halter class.

- Registration papers must be sent with the entry form to show management for verification of name and age. Failure to meet this requirement prohibits entry in the show.

- Non-Breeder llamas must be accompanied by a registration or veterinarian certificate verifying the animal is a gelding, a vasectomized male, or a spayed or non-reproductive female.

- Nursing llama mothers may not be accompanied in the ring by their babies. ALSA recommends not showing nursing mothers.

- Llamas may not be moved from one class to another after halter judging has begun, except at the judges' decision.

- Oral reasons for placings will not be given.

- Show management cannot be responsible for acts of God and War. No refunds after entry deadline.

1. Required entry fees, stall fees and copies of registration certificates must accompany entry form.

2. All exhibitors must be a current member of ALSA or pay a 30.00 member fee PER SHOW. This fee applies to ALL shows - i.e. if you are showing and you are not a member of ALSA you pay \$120.00.

3. All llamas arriving on the grounds must have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection issued within 30 days.

4. There will be a \$5.00 charge for EACH entry change made after the entry deadline. Please check you entries before mailing.

5. **PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT YOUR ANIMALS ARE ENTERED IN THE APPROPRIATE WOOL DIVISION!!! THIS IS ABSOLUTELY NECESSARY FOR THE SHOWS TO RUN SMOOTHLY.**

6. Security will be provided Thursday, Friday and Saturday night.

7. **Stalls for The Grand Slam Llama Event '05 will NOT be with the Celebrity Sale and Futurity entrant stalls. If you have animals entered in the Celebrity Sale and/or Futurity and want to enter The Grand Slam you must get your stalls through Celebrity. If you are only entering The Grand Slam you *MUST* get your stalls through the GRAND SLAM.**

You are encouraged to stay for the entire weekend. You will NOT be charged extra for your stalls.

There will be NO bedding provided in The Grand Slam stalls. You may use straw but NO shredded paper. bedding. 2 ANIMALS PER STALL PLEASE.
