

**Veterinarian:**

There will be a veterinarian on call should any health problems arise. Telephone numbers for the on-call vet will be posted in the show office. Any Vet charges or fees will be between the owner & the veterinarian.

**Class Sponsors:**

New to the Grand Nationals this year is the Organization/Association & Farm level sponsorship. They will be able to sponsor a class during the show. The Association/Organization Sponsorship is \$350.00 & the Farm Level Sponsorship are from \$100.00 to \$250.00. The Farm & Organization sponsorship includes a business card ad in the 2007 Grand National Show Book as well as acknowledgment during the show.

**Entry Forms:**

Please take the time to read this exhibitor instruction sheet so that you can fill out your entry form correctly & fully. Please send legible copies of your ILR or ARI certificates with your entry forms along with a copy of the qualifying notice. If you are not the owner of record (that is, if your name is not on the registration certificate as the owner), you must provide a completed & signed Permission to Show form. Blank Permission to Show forms may be downloaded from the ALSA website. **You must also complete & return the enclosed check sheet.** If you have any questions or doubts about entering classes, please call the show superintendents or the show clerk. There will be no refunds after your deadline.

**Download Qualifying Information & Entry Form:**

All Grand National qualifying information & entry forms are on the ALSA website ([www.alsashow.org](http://www.alsashow.org)). Download your qualifying information, an entry form & check sheet & mail it today. Please print the web page showing the qualifications & include it with your entry. If your animal's qualifications do not appear on the website, please include the name & date of the show at which the animal qualified with your entry. **As a reminder, juvenile llamas do not need to pre-qualify at any regional show.** Your assistance with these details will make the entry process much smoother.

**Directions to the Lancaster Event Center:**

From I-80; Interstate 80 to Exit 409; go southwest on Hwy 6 to 84th Street, turn left & go south to Havelock Ave. On I-29: North to Iowa, Exit 10 or from Hwy 75 North: left on Hwy 1 & go west to Lincoln, right on 84th Street & go north for 8 miles. From Beatrice on Hwy 77: north for 35 miles, right on Old Cheney Road, go east to 84th Street, left on 84th (north) for 7 miles. From Fremont on Hwy 77: south on Hwy 77 to Cornhusker Hwy., east two miles to 84th Street & south one mile to Havelock Avenue.

**Judges' Meeting:**

There will be a meeting for all certified ALSA judges & apprentices Thursday, October 25 @ 6:00 pm at the Lancaster Event Center.

**Arrival:**

There are no specific arrival requirements for exhibitors. However, the planned arrival time is on Thursday, October 25, 2007. General Meeting attendees will want to arrive on Thursday to attend the ILR General Meeting on Thursday, Oct. 25 @ 4:00 pm & the ALSA General Membership meeting on Friday, Oct. 26 @ 7:30 am at the Lancaster Event Center. Crew members may stall their animals as early as Wednesday, Oct. 24, 2007.

**Registration & Check In:**

Registration & check in for the show will be at the Lancaster Event Center all day Thursday & Friday morning. You must submit your health requirement paperwork. Before off loading your animals, take your health certificates to the office for checking in.

**Stalling, Tack Areas & Farm Displays:**

All stalling will be pre-assigned by the stalling crew. **There will be no special stalling requests granted this year.** All stalls are 10' X 10' horse stalls & are \$50.00 each. No more than two llamas are permitted in each stall. If you wish to provide your own panels as stall fronts to improve animal visibility, you must indicate this on your registration form—otherwise there will be a charge for stall front removal. Panels will not be available on site. Stalls may also be purchased as farm displays spaces for \$160.00. Barn aisles must be kept open at all times to permit dust control. Tables and/or chairs will not be permitted in the aisles. Stalls cannot be used as tack areas. Specific tack areas will be provided free of charge. Small (4.5" x 12" max.) black & white For Sale signs will be permitted.

**Single Animals:**

If you are bringing a single animal & need a stalling companion you may call Greg or Debbie Shellabarger at 937-376-2980 & they will try to find one for you.

**Bedding:**

All stall floors are dirt. There will be no bedding provided unless you purchase shredded cardboard or sand. You will need to bring your own mats, carpeting. **Straw/hay & paper products are not permitted.** If you choose to use shredded cardboard or sand as bedding, it must be pre-ordered. The cost for sand is \$30.00 per stall and the cost for cardboard is \$10.00 per bag (suggest that 3 bags per stall be used) and must be purchased on your entry forms. The shredded cardboard bedding is the only paper product that has been approved by the facility's fire insurance carrier. There will be limited amount of sand available at the show.

**Water & Electric:**

Both water & electric are available in the barns. Extension cords may be needed.

**Grooming:**

There is a wash room with hot water. Blowing may be done in the building but **away from the stalls & only at designated areas.** Please have your llamas as show-ready as possible prior to arrival.

**Camping:**

A camping area with water & electricity is available at the facility. Rates are \$25.00 per night & must be prepaid on your entry form. **You must secure a camping permit at the show Office.**
