The 2007 Florida Open ALSA Llama Show will be taking place in Ocala, Florida on February 2 - 4, 2007. We will be using the beautiful arena and facilities of the Ocala Equestrian Complex. Llamas will be housed in the barns adjacent to the arena. Stalls are 10' x 10', solid walled with a door on front. All stalls have access to electric and water is conveniently located.

Due to stall availability, entries are limited to a capacity of 150 stalls. In the event that entries, timely received, exceed available stall space, entries in the main barn will be accepted and assigned on a first come, first served basis (based on postmark). Others will be placed in additional adjacent overflow stall space, if available.

ELIGIBILITY

PER ALSA REGULATIONS: All llamas 5 months and older entered in approved classes, with the exception of Youth Classes, Performance and Adult Showmanship, must be registered with the International Llama Registry (ILR) or the Canadian Livestock Record Corporation (CLRC). Non-breeder llamas do not have to be registered with the ILR or CLRC except those recorded with ALSA and participating in the Awards System. Non-breeder llamas that are not registered must be entered in the Adult non-breeder classes. ***Copies of registration paper(s) must be presented at the show upon check-in.*** All llamas must be entered in the exact name and registration number as shown on the registration certificate. **Owners with llamas registered with ALSA for point accumulation must provide their animal's ALSA number to show management. Entries in Youth Division should be made in the name of the Youth Handler, not the llama.** ALSA Permission to Show forms must be included with registration/entry forms for each llama not owned by the exhibitor. Failure to do so will result in the subject animal registration being voided and returned. **NOTE: Per ALSA rules, the same llama may be entered in a Youth class OR a non-youth (Novice or Advance) class, but not both.**

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

All animals must have an official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (COVI) issued by an accredited veterinarian, dated within 30 days of the show and positive identification. All COVI must show a detailed record of tests given each animal, giving breed, date of test, name and registry number. In addition, verification that non-breeders are geldings, vasectomized males or spayed females should be noted on the face of the COVI. All animals not identified individually by a USDA metal ear tag, tattoo, or microchip must be accompanied by a COVI including a general description of the animal, a photograph of the animal being exhibited, and a notarized letter verifying that the animals being exhibited are those included on the COVI and in the accompanying photographs. All vehicles transporting livestock for exhibition in Florida shall be cleaned and disinfected prior to the loading of such livestock. **NOTE: If you are traveling from out-of-state, be sure to check the requirements for any states you may be traveling through to get to our show.**

ENTRIES & FEES

1. All entries must be postmarked on or before January 8, 2007. Certified mail is recommended. A metered postmark will not be considered as a valid postmark for entry deadline purposes. Entries postmarked after Jan. 8th will be subject to management approval and availability of stall space. The only way an entry received after the deadline will be considered is for the exhibitor to furnish a certified mail receipt verifying that the entry was mailed on/or prior to January 8, 2007.
2. **All entries should be mailed to Florida Open Llama Show Association, Inc., 7108 229th Street East, Bradenton, Florida 34211.** Entry Fees, forms and copies of ILR registration papers must be included. **Checks should be made payable to: Florida Open Llama Show Association, Inc.**
3. Entry fees per animal for all exhibitors are \$70.00 for 1-2 animals, \$65.00 for 3-6 animals and \$60.00 per animal for more than 7 animals. In addition, there is a mandatory \$15.00 per animal ALSA Recording Fee (*\$5.00 per animal per judge*). This entitles you to register for as many classes as you and/or your animal qualify for.

DIRECTIONS

From I-75, take EXIT 352, SR 40. Turn west onto FL 40/W. Silver Springs Blvd. Go to the intersection with NW 60th Ave/CR-225A. Turn left onto NW 60th Ave/CR-225A. Turn left into the Complex at 1601 SW 60th Ave. The Complex is adjacent to the Ocala Airport and is only minutes from I-75. The office phone number is 352-237-6667. Guests can easily reach a wide variety of restaurants and lodging establishments.

ENTRY FEES MUST BE PAID FOR ALL ANIMALS BROUGHT TO THIS SHOW.

4. Entry Forms must be filled out correctly and in full. Exhibitor's Social Security number must be included for premium checks to be generated. All llamas entered in the show MUST be registered with the International Llama Registry (ILR) or the Canadian Livestock Records Corporation (CLRC), except as noted. A copy of ILR registration papers for all animals listed must accompany the entry form. The only exceptions are: non-breeder llamas (unless ALSA points are desired); llamas used only in youth classes; and juvenile llamas which should at least have a copy of the registration application. Registration papers must be presented to Show Management for verification of name and age. Failure to meet this requirement prohibits entry in the show. All llamas must be entered in the exact name and registration number as shown on their registration certificate. The ALSA number for llamas recorded with ALSA for point accumulation must be provided to Show Management. Entries in the Youth Division should be made in the name of the Youth Handler, not the llama. Only wool classification may be changed after the entries close. Make sure to enter your llamas in all classes you want them shown. ***No additions to classes will be accepted after the registration deadline...NO EXCEPTIONS.*** Animals may be scratched from a class until time to enter the staging area.

5. All entries must be in good standing as of January 15th, 2007 or they will be deleted from the show. Returned checks will be charged a \$20.00 fee, which must be paid by cashiers check or money order along with the original amount by January 15th, 2007 or the entry will be null & void.

6. **SUBSTITUTIONS:** All substitutions must be received by January 15, 2007. No substitutions will be allowed upon arrival. Additional animals will be treated as a late entry and will not be allowed.

7. **CANCELLATIONS:** Notice of cancellations must be received by January 15, 2007 in order to qualify for refund of fees. Cancellations may be made by telephone, fax or e-mail. Confirmation must be made by letter and received no later than January 15, 2007.

8. **STALLS:** There are 150 stalls available this year for animals and tack/display. Fee for all stalls is \$40.00 per stall. We are requesting that you house 2 adults or 3 weanlings per stall when possible so that we will be able to accommodate everyone who wants to attend the show. **PLEASE NOTE: ONLY MATS or COASTAL HAY <See Registration form> CAN BE USED IN THE STALLS FOR BEDDING.**

9. **TACK/DISPLAY:** Space for tack or farm display may be reserved for \$40.00 per 10' x 10' space. There will be a limit of ONE additional stall per farm for tack and/or display (*we encourage sharing of tack space*).

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. By application for entry to the Show, each exhibitor certifies that all exhibits are in accordance with the rules and regulations of ALSA and that the exhibitor agrees to be governed by these rules.

2. Electricity and water will be available. We recommend that you bring fans and extension cords (*a power strip with breaker is required per Complex regulations*) to keep animals cool.

3. Wash Racks are available adjacent to the barns if you wish to bathe your animal(s).

4. Please put your name and phone number where you are staying on the tag provided on your stall in case you are needed during the night.

5. There will be a veterinarian on call. Exhibitors are responsible for any fees incurred.

Florida Open Llama Show - Addendum

OWNER represents to Florida Open Llama Show ("LLAMA SHOW") that no animals that are exhibited or otherwise transported onto the Ocala Equestrian Complex grounds (OEC) will in anyway be suffering from any contagious or infectious disease. In addition, OWNER shall defend, indemnify, and hold the LLAMA SHOW, the applicable Show Committee and each of their respective officials, officers, directors, employees and agents harmless of and from all losses, damages, claims, expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees at the trial and appellate levels, actions and causes of action arising out of, or in any way connected with, or by reason of this Agreement, the presence of OWNER's livestock at the OEC, and/or use of OEC facilities including, but not limited to any claim for the death of, or injury to any person or livestock, or damage to, theft of, or destruction of any property arising out of any act or omission of OWNER, OWNER's officers, agents, employees, trainers, drivers, riders, handlers, contractors and livestock, violation of any Federal, State and Local environmental laws, rules, ordinances and/or regulations, actions for negligence, wrongful death, torts, defects in the real and personal property at the OEC facility and from any alleged liability, cause, litigation or proceeding whatsoever, even if such injury, death, loss or property damage results, in whole or in part, from the negligence of the LLAMA SHOW, or the applicable Show Committee and their respective officials, officers, directors, employees and agents or otherwise. Neither LLAMA SHOW nor such applicable Show Committee shall be liable to OWNER, or any officer, agents, employees, trainers, drivers, riders, handlers, or other contractors, invitees or guests of OWNER for any injury or damage to livestock, person or property. LLAMA SHOW, its officers or agents, assume no liability for any loss or damage to property (including but not limited to livestock) on account of fire, theft, or any other cause including infectious or contagious diseases. In addition, OWNER acknowledges receiving and agrees to abide by the applicable rules and regulations of the LLAMA SHOW and same are incorporated by reference herein.

ARRIVAL

1. Arrival Time for all exhibitors is 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. on Friday, February 2nd, 2007. All stalls will be assigned prior to your arrival. Barn maps will be posted. See Show Staff personnel for help locating your stall(s) upon arrival.

2. Upon arrival, unload, stall animals and park your vehicle before checking in at the registration desk in the office to receive your show packet.

3. **PARKING:** Llama Exhibitors will park vehicles and trailers in the field adjacent to the facility. (Ask our staff for directions)

4. **EARLY ARRIVALS:** Early arrivals will be permitted upon receipt of a written request submitted to the Show by January 8th, 2007 in cases where the scheduled arrival time presents a hardship due to weather, travel time, etc. The Exhibitor will be notified by January 15th, 2007 if the request has been approved. Early arrival fees will apply. (See Registration/Entry Form)

5. An Exhibitor Meeting will be held on Saturday, February 3rd, at 8:00 a.m. in the show arena. You will meet the judge and have a chance to ask any questions and/or receive any last minute instruction, information or materials. IT IS VERY IMPORTANT FOR ALL EXHIBITORS TO ATTEND THIS MEETING!

EXHIBITOR DINNER

There will be a catered dinner on Saturday, February 3rd, at 7:00 p.m. inside the arena for all Llama exhibitors and their families. Cost for this dinner is \$8.00. Make sure that you include payment for your dinner tickets with your entry.

CLASSES

A list of classes is enclosed. The final schedule will be announced at the Exhibitor Meeting on Saturday morning. Take care to choose the correct class number for the class or classes you wish to enter your animal(s) in. NOTE: Animals may only be entered in one division of a class. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter the correct class division, per ALSA rules.

YOUTH CLASSES - Youth classes are open to any and all youth, 8 to 18 years of age (*as of January 1, 2007 per ALSA rules*). For ALSA classes, any Youth that turns 8 during the year is eligible to show as of his/her birthday. NOTE: Per ALSA rules, the same llama may be entered in a Youth class OR a non-youth (Novice or Advance) class, but not both.

YOUTH JUDGING CONTEST - See your ALSA handbook for details and requirements for this class. PLEASE NOTE: In order to participate in the Youth Judging Contest, participants must be a Youth Llama Exhibitor that is showing an animal, and submit an entry form that indicates they are entering the Youth Judging Contest class.

HALTER CLASSES - You must show your llama(s) in the AGE Halter Class and the Wool Length Halter Class in which they qualify. Wool, Sex & Age and class divisions are listed below. NOTE: EXHIBITORS MUST SEND A COPY OF ILR REGISTRATION WITH THEIR ENTRY TO COMPETE IN ALSA HALTER CLASSES. Base date for computing age of animal is February 2nd, 2007.

WOOL DIVISIONS

Light Wool - Minimal body wool, short neck wool with smooth legs.

Medium Wool - Moderate to long body wool, minimal to moderate neck wool, smooth to moderate leg wool.

Heavy Wool - Abundant body and neck wool with minimal to abundant leg wool. (*i.e. leg wool at least to knee and hock*)

Suri Wool - Fiber grouped into a very distinctive, well defined lock structure indicated by many individual separate locks of fiber formed at the skin and carrying out to the ends of each lock.

Shorn Llamas - Shorn llamas must be shown in the wool division in which they would have been shown prior to shearing.

SEX AND AGE DIVISIONS (Males / Females / Non-Breeding Llamas)

1. *Juvenile* - 5 months through 12 months

2. *Yearling* - 13 months through 24 months

3. *Two Year Old* - 25 months through 36 months

4. *Adult* - 37 months and over

On llama's date of birth, llama moves up to the next older class. Age as of February 2, 2007 determines age division.

CLASSES (continued)

CLASS DIVISIONS

Novice - Open to all entries who have fewer than three ribbons in either 1st, 2nd or 3rd place in Open, Novice or Youth division of the respective ALSA approved class. After placing once, 1st, 2nd or 3rd, the llama may enter Advanced.

Advanced - Open to all entries who have previously placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in the Open, Novice or Youth division of the respective ALSA approved class or deemed capable of competing at the advanced level by its owner. **Once a llama has entered an Advanced class it is no longer eligible to compete in Novice, regardless of placement.**

Pack Classes – Each exhibitor must provide their own pack. ALSA rules require packs to have a minimum of two body cinches with saddle. Weights will be available if needed or you can supply your own, to be weighed in before class begins. The panniers are to be bulged out with newspaper to give the appearance of a full pack. Llamas and Alpacas must be at least 5 months of age to compete in Novice or Advanced pack classes. Llamas 18 to 36 months old must carry a pack system or training pack filled with lightweight material to simulate a full pack. Llamas 37 months or older must have a pack with removable panniers and carry a minimum weight of 40 lbs.

Youth Pack Classes – The llama must be 5 months or older and carry a two cinch pack. Panniers do not have to be removable – up to 36 months, only lightweight material. Llamas over 36 months can carry up to 25 lbs. in the Intermediate class.

Young Pack - For Pack classes only, in conjunction with Open or Advanced and Novice divisions. The age of the llama or alpaca is 5 – 36 months old.

Group Classes

GET-OF-SIRE – Each entry must include three offspring by the same sire, by at least two different dams. The offspring may be either sex. There must be only one entry per sire. All get must be shown first in their appropriate halter class. The sire will not be shown in this class.

PRODUCE-OF-DAM – Each entry must include two offspring of either sex from the same dam. There must be only one entry per dam. Produce must be shown first in their appropriate halter class. The dam will not be shown in this class.

NOTE – The Get-Of-Sire or Produce-of-Dam may be decided after halter classes but must be registered with the clerk prior to these classes being held.

YOUTH PERFORMANCE CHAMPION – In order to qualify, youth must compete in Youth Obstacle, PR and Pack, and use the same animal for all three classes unless the animal is less than 12 months old. In that case only, the Youth may use a second animal in the Youth Pack class.

VERSATILITY GRAND CHAMPION – This award will be given to any llama, female, male or gelding, which shows overall excellence by placing well in numerous show events. To be eligible, the animal must be shown in a halter class and at least two performance classes.

BEING LATE

Exhibitors are encouraged to be prompt for each of their classes during show time. Announcements will be made in the barn to have classes proceed to the holding area at the show arena. Once the class has entered the arena, late exhibitors may not enter the class. Handlers are encouraged to take all animals to the “facilities” provided in the holding area BEFORE they enter the show ring. Let’s all try to keep the ring clean to show in!!!!
